5 Fun Ideas for Over-the-Top Mug Cakes

Let your imagination go wild and create anything you want. I can't wait to see the pics!

1. Chocolate Mug Cake - Top with ice cream, caramel sauce, fresh berries and an Oreo cookie to finish it off. (Try canned cherry pie filling if you have some.)
2. Double Chocolate Mug Cake – Top with a generous amount of whipped cream, more mini chocolate chips and chocolate sauce.
3. Triple Chocolate Mug Cake – Before baking in the microwave lay a piece of chocolate on top of the cake batter. Bake and cool as usual. Top with chocolate ice cream, white and dark shaved chocolate or chocolate sprinkles.
4. Love Cake – Pile on loads of whipped cream, drizzle with raspberry sauce, decorate with heart shaped sprinkles plus a heart shaped sugar cookie to top it off.
5. Funfetti Mug Cake Sundae – Top with your favourite ice cream, whipped cream, more sprinkles and a maraschino cherry on top. What about a banana split cake?
